The national standard is that all patients are automatically opted in to each of the electronic record sharing arrangements detailed below; **every patient has the right to choose to OPT OUT.** This is entirely your choice; if you wish to opt out please complete the form held at reception, indicating which of the three schemes you wish to opt out of.

SUMMARY CARE RECORD - This is a summary of your Medication, Allergies & Adverse Reactions and can only be accessed by a Clinician in England with your consent at the point of care. **In an emergency this information can be very helpful to clinicians.** Further information can be found at the web site - <http://systems.hscic.gov.uk/scr/patients>

LOCAL HEALTH RECORD - This allows access to your **FULL** Health Record to Out of Hours Service, Secondary Care (Hospital) Clinicians and can only be accessed with your consent at the time the care is provided to you. Further information is available the New Devon CCG website:
