



SHARING YOUR MEDICAL RECORD WITH HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS

Your medical records are held securely by the practice. There are **three** ways that your information can be shared electronically with authorised medical professionals who are not employed by the practice.

The national standard is that all patients are automatically OPTED IN to each of the below; every patient has the right to choose to OPT OUT.

This is entirely your choice; if you wish to opt out please complete the following indicating which of the three schemes you wish to opt out of.

<p><u>SUMMARY CARE RECORD</u> - This is a summary of your Medication, Allergies & Adverse Reactions and can only be accessed by a Clinician in England with your consent at the point of care. For further information the web site is - http://systems.hscic.gov.uk/scr/patients</p>	
<p><u>LOCAL HEALTH RECORD</u> - This allows access to your FULL Health Record to Out of Hours Service, Secondary Care (Hospital) Clinicians in Devon and can only be accessed with your consent at point of care. <p><u>CARE.DATA</u> - The care.data programme receives health and social care information from different settings in order to see what's working really well in the NHS and what could be done better. This is not accessible to clinicians and is for statistical Purpose Only. GP surgeries by law have to allow the transfer of your data.
